

But GLAZE isn't sitting still. The company is gearing up to launch NOBILITA, its new premium porcelain brand from Modena, Italy. And if you know Modena, you'll know the



DNA: Ferrari, Ducati, Brioni, Acetaia balsamic. Excellence is baked into the culture there. NOBILITA carries that same weight, slabs crafted at 160×320 cm, in 6 mm and 12 mm thickness, built for everything from flooring to cladding and countertops.

The name says it all. Nobilita draws from the nobili, Italy's noble class who once lived on the piano nobile, the noble floor of baroque palaces. Each design is developed from marble carefully handpicked from Italy's best quarries. The result? A porcelain product that captures the elegance and timelessness of natural stone but delivers the scale, durability, and functionality that today's projects demand.

Why it matters
